Our competition is open to all local California growers. All entries must be Heirloom Tomatoes defined as open pollinated, non-hybrid, non-GMO and non-patented varieties. Tomatoes are judged on their overall quality based on appearance, flavor and texture.

Entry Fee: \$3.00 for every tomato variety entered

Entry Limits: 4 tomato varieties per category
