HAWKEYE MOUNTAIN

Sourced from the ridge along the westward face of the Mayacamas Mountains, the vineyards are perched high above the valley floor. Fog strains to reach the chilled top of the vineyard area, resulting in large temperature swings daily which are only tempered by the constant winds driven by the Pacific Ocean.

KEY POINTS

Elevation: 900 - 2200 feet

Soil: Shallow, rocky and gravelly

loam on steep hillsides, with

some terracing.

Climate: Cool mornings that gradually

lead to warm nights in this

mountainous area above the fogline.

Profile: Deep black cherry, cassis and

red currant flavors with graceful mineral tones. Artistically extracted, elegantly muscular,

with chewy, soft tannins.
